- 28 Sauvignon Blanc 2017 – Kuki (New Zealand)** **25.95**
The grape that put New Zealand on the world wine map. Lovely crisp fresh gooseberry and grassy flavours that linger. New Zealand is now producing the Worlds favourite Sauvignon and it is easy to see why. Fabulous!
- 29 Puligny Montrachet 'Les Houilleres' 2014** **48.50**
Domaine Machard de Gramont (Burgundy)
A stunning wine from a small 2/3 ha plot. Aged in 50% new oak, this is a red crowd pleaser!
- 30 Meursault 2011 - Domaine Michelot (Burgundy)** **48.50**
Big rich hazelnut flavours that literally ooze from the glass.
Classic wine from one of the finest producers in Meursault.
- 58 Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Vergers 2010 – Domaine Guy Amiot (Burgundy)** **79.00**
The outstanding producer in the village of Chassagne Montrachet!
A great vintage! Need I say more!
- 57 St Aubin 1er Cru 2011 “En Remilly” Domaine Lamy – Burgundy** **65.00**
Offering an incredible confluence of deep, ripe, citrus and flower essences and a creamy, fleshy texture which then all leads to a massive charge of citric and chalky energy to close.

European Red Wines

- 32 Tempranillo – Rioja Vega (Spain)** **21.95**
Very fruity, velvety smooth Rioja made without any oak. Lovely easy drinking and excellent value for money.
- 33 Fleurie 2015 - Domaine Pardon (France)** **25.95**
The epitome of Beaujolais, soft, silky and racy!
- 34 Château d'Angludet 2011 - Margaux (Bordeaux)** **39.95**
Owned and run by the Sichel family who also part own the fabulous Chateau Palmer. This is now one of the jewels of the Margaux appellation and certainly offers the finest value for money in the region. 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot and 10% Petit Verdot.
- 35 Primitivo Appassimento 2016 - Carlomagno (Italy)** **22.95**
Sun soaked damsons and blackberries deliver a fruit filled palate with soft tannins to reach a delicious finish.
- 36 Rioja Vega 2008 – Gran Reserva (Spain)** **48.00**
I discovered this excellent wine when visiting Rioja at the end of September. We drank it with rare beef. “A marriage made in heaven”.
- 37 Old Vines Carignan – Xavier Roger (Southern France)** **19.95**
Morello cherry and hedgerow fruits on the nose. The palate is soft and supple with good structure and mouth feel. Lovely drinking.



European Red Wines

- 40 Château Corbin 2012 - Montagne St. Emilion (France) 27.50**
One of the oldest properties in Montagne St. Emilion producing a stunningly fruity wine from 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 42 Nuits St Georges "En La Perriere Noblot" 2013 – Machard de Gramont (Burgundy) 48.00**
Packed with delicious red fruit flavours, lovely rounded palate – beautifully balanced with a long aftertaste. Pinot Noir is grown all over the world but Burgundy is it's true home where it shows how very special it is.
- 44 Megaphone 2013 'Ventoux' – F & D Brunier (Rhône) 29.95**
Frederic and Daniel Brunier are the owner/winemakers at Domaine de Vieux Telegraph, one of the great Chateaux du Pape. Only 580 cases were made of this delicious wine and we have been fortunate enough to secure a few. A blend of 80% Grenache and 20% Syrah, it has a deep serious nose of liquorice and black fruits. Velvety smooth with flavours that linger. Quite delicious!
- 45 Rioja Vega 2011 "Reserva" (Rioja, Spain) 35.00**
Fabulous full bodied Rioja. Aged in oak casks for 2 years followed by further ageing in the bottle. Ripe cherry red – intense complex aromas of black fruits, leather, balsam and spices. Excellent!
- 47 Amarone della Valpolicella 2012/13 - Giuseppi Lonardi (Italy) 65.00**
One of the truly unique wines of Italy – March 2012 edition of "Decanter Magazine" made this the highest rated Amarone – Fabulous!
- 48 Shiraz – Monastier (Southern France) 21.50**
In the south of France Alain Grignon has produced a full, soft rich flavoursome Shiraz that is more Aussie than Australia can produce.
- 49 Chateau Trillo 2011 - Corbieres (Southern France) 26.00**
Wow! This is quite stunning – big, rich, packed with ripe fruit. Beautifully balanced with great length!

New World Red Wines

- 51 Merlot – El Picador (Chile) 21.00**
Hints of plum and jam on the bouquet. Medium bodied with a chocolate note and hint of spice.
- 52 Pinot Noir 2014 - Kuki (New Zealand) 28.50**
A beguiling, sensual and smoky Pinot Noir. The palate shows bright cherry and brambly berry with firm tannins giving succulent length and suppleness.
- 56 Malbec 'Lunta' 2014 - Mendel (Argentina) 26.75**
The classic Argentinean grape. Big, rich powerful wine – intense damson fruit flavours and a finish that goes on and on!
