- 31 Chardonnay - Turi (Chile)** **17.95**
If there is a better value for money Chardonnay than this, we have yet to find it. Lovely rich melon and peach flavours balanced by refreshing acidity.
- 32 Sauvignon Blanc 2012 – Kuki (New Zealand)** **24.50**
The grape that put New Zealand on the world wine map. Lovely crisp fresh gooseberry and grassy flavours that linger. New Zealand is now producing the Worlds favourite Sauvignon and it is easy to see why. Fabulous!
- 33 Gewurztraminer ‘Los Gansos’ – Concha y Toro (Chile)** **20.95**
Very aromatic and spicy – A full flavoured wine from a top Chilean producer.
- 34 Chenin Blanc – Avondale (South Africa)** **21.75**
A totally organic and biodynamic producer. Forget supermarket Chenin this is the real thing. Quite delicious.
- 35 ‘Water Race’ Riesling – Domaine Road (New Zealand)** **28.50**
Steely minerality – totally refreshing with a flavour that lingers – Riesling is possibly the least understood grape variety yet is perfect with seafood and fish!
- 17 Omahu Road Chardonnay 2011 – C J Pask (New Zealand)** **26.75**
Intense citrus aromas are apparent in this full flavoured and elegant unoaked Chardonnay – delicious!

- 36 Garnacha Rosé - Pleno (Spain)** **17.95**
A bouquet of delicious fresh strawberries. Packed with fruit and so easy to drink. Spain has been producing lovely Rosé long before we began to appreciate them.
- 37 Pinot Grigio Rosé – Pure (Italy)** **18.95**
Pinot Grigio is popular! – Rose is popular! Have the best of both!
- 38 Côte de Provence 2012 – Chateau de Roquefort (Southern France)** **25.95**
A stunning wine made organically from one of the regions finest producers. Hedonistic!

- 39 Tempranillo 2012 – Rioja Vega (Spain) 19.75**
Very fruity, velvety smooth Rioja made without any oak. Lovely easy drinking and excellent value for money.
- 40 Fleurie 2012 - Domaine Pardon (France) 23.95**
The epitome of Beaujolais, soft, silky and racy!
- 41 Château d'Angludet 2007 - Margaux (Bordeaux) 39.75**
Owned and run by the Sichel family who also part own the fabulous Chateau Palmer. This is now one of the jewels of the Margaux appellation and certainly offers the finest value for money in the region. 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot and 10% Petit Verdot.
- 42 Valpolicella Ripasso 2010 - Villalta (Italy) 22.75**
Ripasso denotes the wine has been enhanced with the grape skins used for making Amarone, giving the wine greater depth of flavour.
- 43 Le Charme Shiraz (France) 17.95**
Rich and ripe, with sweet peppery fruit and well balanced tannins. Who needs Aussie Shiraz!
- 44 Old Vines Carignan – Xavier Roger (Southern France) 19.95**
Morello cherry and hedgerow fruits on the nose. The palate is soft and supple with good structure and mouth feel. Lovely drinking.
- 45 Navarra Cianza 2009 - Principe de Viana (Spain) 19.95**
If you like Rioja you will love this. Navarra is just to the east of Rioja and produces wine in a similar style, except this has more rich soft easy drinking fruit and is much better value for money. A personal favourite!
- 46 Chateau Moulin de Mallet 2010 (Bordeaux) 21.50**
A lovely Claret that demonstrates just how good the 2010 vintage is. Full of ripe juicy fruit, easy drinking and great value.
- 47 Château Corbin 2009 - Montagne St. Emilion (France) 24.95**
One of the oldest properties in Montagne St. Emilion producing a stunningly fruity wine from 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 48 Gevrey Chambertin 'Vieilles Vignes' 2006 – Domaine Serafin (Burgundy) 65.00**
There are two outstanding domaines in Gevrey Chambertin, the other one being Rousseau. A 'stonking' wine that really delivers on flavour – excellent!

EUROPEAN RED WINES (OLD WORLD)

- 49 Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Fonteny 2004 - Domaine Serafin (Burgundy) 87.50**
All Gevrey Chambertin should be this good! Now showing at its best – good drinking!
- 50 Nuits St Georges "En La Perriere Noblot" 2009 – Machard de Gramont (Burgundy) 42.00**
Packed with delicious red fruit flavours, lovely rounded palate – beautifully balanced with a long aftertaste. Pinot Noir is grown all over the world but Burgundy is its true home where it shows how very special it is.
- 51 Volnay 2003 – Domaine Voillot (Burgundy) 45.00**
Lovely wine from a top producer. Now starting to show at its best. This wine demonstrates just why Burgundy is so very special.
- 52 Megaphone 2011 'Ventoux' – F & D Brunier (Rhône) 28.95**
Frederic and Daniel Brunier are the owner/winemakers at Domaine de Vieux Telegraph, one of the great Chateaux du Pape. Only 580 cases were made of this delicious wine and we have been fortunate enough to secure a few. A blend of 80% Grenache and 20% Syrah, it has a deep serious nose of liquorice and black fruits. Velvety smooth with flavours that linger. Quite delicious!
- 53 Chateau Gruard Larose 1998 2eme Cru St Julien (Bordeaux) 95.00**
Stunning wine now drinking beautifully.
- 54 Rioja Vega 2008 "Reserva" (Rioja, Spain) 31.50**
Fabulous full bodied Rioja. Aged in oak casks for 2 years followed by further ageing in the bottle. Ripe cherry red – intense complex aromas of black fruits, leather, balsam and spices. Excellent!
- 55 Chateaux du Pape 2011 – Telegramme (Rhône) 49.50**
From the superb Domaine Vieux Telegraph a lovely rich perfectly balanced wine, full of white pepper spicy overtones. Delicious!
- 56 Crozes-Hermitage 2011 - Domaine Pochon (France) 26.00**
Big rich powerful Syrah fruit yet perfectly balanced and quite delicious. Crozes Hermitage from a top grower like Pochon really gives good value for money.
- 57 Amarone della Valpolicella 2010 - Giuseppi Lonardi (Italy) 57.00**
One of the truly unique wines of Italy – March 2012 edition of "Decanter Magazine" made this the highest rated Amarone – Fabulous!
- 58 Shiraz – Monastier (Southern France) 19.95**
In the south of France Alain Grignon has produced a full, soft rich flavoursome Shiraz that is more Aussie than Australia can produce.
- 68 Chateau Trillo 2008 - Corbieres (Southern France) 26.00**
Wow! This is quite stunning – big, rich, packed with ripe fruit. Beautifully balanced with great length!

NEW WORLD RED WINES

- 59 Merlot - Turi (Chile)** **17.95**
If there is a better Merlot from Chile we are yet to find it. Lovely rich plummy fruit flavours soft tannins with a touch of spice and long finish. Dangerously drinkable.
- 60 Pinot Noir 2005 – Foxes Island - (New Zealand)** **28.50**
In the next 10-20 years New Zealand will become better known for it's Pinot Noirs than it's Sauvignon Blanc. Remember you heard it here first! Lovely cherry and strawberry fruit on the palate – silky smooth taste and lovely finish. Drinking superbly!
- 61 Carmenere - Turi (Chile)** **18.95**
A little similar to Merlot but with more of everything. Richness, spice and pepper and flavour. Lovely wine!
- 62 Malbec-Shiraz – Las Manitos (Argentina)** **18.95**
Wow! Absolutely packed with ripe red and black fruit flavours – velvety smooth with a good finish. A stunner!
- 63 Barbera 2010 – Chalk Hill (Australia)** **34.95**
Quite an amazing wine. This is more Italian than most Italian Barberas. One of our favourites.
- 64 Shiraz 2012 - Pitch Fork (Australia)** **21.95**
'It does what it says on the tin'. Classic Aussie Shiraz, big, rich, dark fruit flavours, a touch of spice, velvety smooth - slips down a treat!
- 65 Malbec 'Lunta' 2012 - Mendel (Argentina)** **24.75**
The classic Argentinean grape. Big, rich powerful wine – intense damson fruit flavours and a finish that goes on and on!
- 66 Graham 2004 - Avondale Estate (South Africa)** **33.50**
Wow! A super wine that got a Veritas Double Gold Award (the highest possible) in South Africa. A classic blend of Cabernet, Merlot and Cab Franc. Big rich fruit flavours and velvety smooth. If this was French it would cost £50!
- 67 Zinfandel Reserve 2008 – Irvine (Australia)** **44.50**
Australia may not be able to compete at the 'House Wine' end of the market due to the exchange rate but at the quality end they are producing some stunning wines. This classic 'Californian' grape variety won 'Worlds Best Red Wine' a few years ago at the International Wine Challenge in London. A must try wine that should be on everyone's 'bucket list'.
